Replacement programme for wheeled bins Green bins in some areas of Walsall have now been in service in excess of 18 years and, at worst, as many as 98,000 bins could potentially be coming to the end of their useful lives. There is increasing evidence that these bins are now beginning to fail, albeit in small numbers. Consideration needs to be given to how we will manage replacement of these bins and how this will be funded. The expected outcome from the Panel's consideration of this issue is that a recommendation (or recommendations) will be put forward to Cabinet for consideration on 15 September 2010.	<u>Enclosed</u>
6.	Provision of Residents Only Parking Zones Residents only parking zones are a tool designed to protect residents from the negative impacts of commuter parking. Such zones are of particular relevance in areas close to town centres and venues that attract high visitor numbers. The existing criteria for introduction of residents parking schemes were last reviewed and approved in 1991 by the Highways and Public Works Committee and no longer meets the needs of the 21 st century.	<u>Enclosed</u>
