Purpose of the report:	To seek approval from Schools Forum for the dates regarding the discussion around Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) allocations and usage for 2011/12 and 2012/13 that will be reported to the Department of Education. The report also informs that Grant Thornton the council's auditors were satisfied with the 2011/12 DSG statement.

1. Background

- 1.1. All councils are asked to return 3 statements to the DfE on an annual basis. In the autumn 2 of these are due, Walsall responses are required on Deployment of DSG: Outturn 2011/12 and allocation of DSG budget 2012/13.
- 1.2. The Chief Finance Officer (CFO) of Walsall Council (James Walsh) has to sign these 2 statements on behalf of the council (**Appendix 1 and 2**). This report covers the points that the CFO will be signing for.

2. 2011-12 DSG (Appendix 1)

- 2.1. The CFO confirms that the DSG was correctly deployed
- 2.2. The CFO attaches a copy of the note that was included in Walsall council's statement of accounts (Appendix 3).
- 2.3. The CFO has to confirm that the audit undertaken by Grant Thornton had no adverse statements. There were no adverse statements. The report can be accessed here:

- 2.4. The rest of the report focuses on the Schools Financial Value Standard

3. 2012-13 DSG

- 3.1. The note to be signed by the CFO with respect to the 2012-13 budgeted DSG contains the following paragraph: "I James Walsh confirm that Walsall local authority's 2012-13 DSG allocation announced by the Department on 26 June 2012, and modified by any positive or negative DSG balance brought forward from 2011-12, will be fully allocated in support of the Schools Budget."
- 3.2. The announcement on 26 June has not impacted Walsall's plans. The variance was less than 0.01% on initial plans. The budgeted amounts were discussed in depth in March 2012
- 3.3. Walsall Council is proposing that **9 October 2012** should be the applicable date.

- 4.2. Schools Forum is asked to approve the use of 9 October 2012 for the 2012/13 DSG budget statement.
- 4.3. Schools Forum is asked to note that Grant Thornton have made no adverse statements regarding the 2011/12 DSG expenditure
- 4.4. Schools Forum is asked to note that very high level of accuracy in forecasting pupil numbers.

44. Dedicated schools grant

The council's expenditure on schools is funded by grant monies provided by Department for Education, the Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG). DSG is ring-fenced and can only be applied to meet expenditure properly included in the schools budget. The schools budget includes elements for a restricted range of services provided on a council wide basis and for the individual schools budget (ISB), which is divided into budget shares for each school. Over and under spends on the two elements are required to be accounted for separately. The council has not supplemented the schools budget from its own resources this year.

Details of the deployment of DSG receivable for 2011/12 which has been deployed in accordance with the Schools Standard and Framework Act (1998 14) are shown in the following table:
