#### ENFORCEMENT ACTION IN THE WILLENHALL AREA

A report has been requested on this subject. Attached is a list of enforcement actions in the Borough. It is extracted from a quarterly report to the Development Control Committee. It includes all the cases in the Willenhall area.

It has been suggested that a separate list for purely Willenhall Cases is appropriate. My advice would be that such a list would be very misleading.

By showing you all cases, Borough-wide, you are able to see what is happening in other areas and how many cases are on hand overall. There is a small team dealing with such cases, and it is not possible for all cases to proceed as rapidly as all parties might like. This can be a concern. By having access to the wider picture, such concerns can be set in context.

It should be stressed that the list is only of investigations that are at a formal stage. There are many more cases which are simply complaints, or continuing investigations.
