- (6) That Council delegate the function of investigating and determining complaints, and managing the arrangements for dealing with complaints to the Standards Committee of the Council, and the Monitoring Officer.
- (7) That the Council delegate power to grant dispensations as set out in paragraph 3.10 of this report.
