## **Grounds Maintenance Standards Within the Borough's Parks**

### 1. Summary of report:

1.1 This report seeks to inform the Community Services Scrutiny Panel of the grounds maintenance standards which apply to the Borough's parks and open spaces managed by Green Spaces.

# 2. Background papers:

Grounds Maintenance – Service Level agreement between Green Spaces and Street Pride, Green Space Strategy

# 3. Reason for scrutiny:

- 3.1 The Green Space Service is responsible for the management and development of over 1,262 hectares of public open space including formal parks, recreation grounds, countryside sites, nature reserves and allotment sites. In all the Service holds management responsibility for over 286 individual sites varying considerably in size and character.
- 3.2 In February 09 the direct responsibility for undertaking grounds maintenance operations within the Formal Parks, Recreation grounds and Open Spaces managed by Green Spaces transferred to Street Pride along with the relevant budgets, staff and other operational resources.
- 3.3 A service level agreement has been established between Green Spaces and Street pride which aims to define the relationship, role and responsibilities between the two service areas in the delivery of the grounds maintenance service and includes a number of key areas including:
  - Baseline Standards
  - Monitoring and Non-Performance
  - Communications, Correspondence and Customer Liaison
  - Meetings and Stakeholder Engagement
  - Amendments & Variations
  - Events
  - Arboricultural Maintenance
  - Children's Play Areas
  - Call Outs
  - Health & Safety
  - Green Flag Parks

- Walsall Arboretum
- Supporting the Park Ranger Service
- 3.4 The Service Level Agreement identifies three base line standards of maintenance which will apply to the individual parks and open spaces. These are Green Flag Parks, Premier Parks and Other Parks and Open Spaces. Each of these categories will have differing standards of maintenance applied to them.
- 3.5 At the time of the transfer it was agreed between Green Spaces and Street Pride that specific standards to be achieved within each category would not be initially defined. This would be done 12 months following the transfer allowing a settling in of the realigned resources, the expected learning curve and when the full effect of the efficiencies which included operational staff reductions were realised.
- 3.6 During 2008 Cabinet endorsed the continued programme to a achieve Green Flag Award status for the Council's other premier parks as set out in the Council's adopted Green Space Strategy. The assessment considers 8 key criteria which includes:
  - A welcoming place
  - Healthy safe and secure
  - Clean and well maintained
  - Sustainability
  - Conservation and heritage
  - Community Involvement
  - Marketing
  - Management
- 3.7 Green Flag status has been achieved at both Palfrey Park and Willenhall Memorial Park and as a condition of the Arboretum HLF Grant Award it is expected that the Arboretum will also achieve this status once the HLF modernisation programme is completed in 2013. All these sites have dedicated gardening staff allocated to them.
- 3.8 The Green Space Strategy identified a number of premier parks and open spaces. The Green Space Service will produce management plans that define standards of maintenance required for each premier park to bring them up to green flag status over the next 15 years. These include:
  - Arboretum
  - The Airport Playing Fields
  - Blackwood Park
  - Doe Bank Park
  - George Rose Park
  - Holland Park
  - King George Vth Playing Fields
  - Kings Hill Park
  - Leamore Park
  - Leighswood Park

- Palfrey Park
- Pelsall Common
- Pleck Park
- Reedswood Park
- Willenhall Memorial Park
- 3.9 All the premier parks are maintained by specific and dedicated mobile teams who are allocated responsibility for the maintenance of individual parks sites ensuring ownership and accountability.
- 3.10 The remaining areas of open space are maintained by geographically based mobile teams. The four geographical contract areas are as follows:
  - 1. Willenhall and Darlaston
  - 2. Bloxwich, Blakenall and Leamore
  - 3. Pelsall, Walsall Wood, Brownhills, Aldridge, Streetly and Pheasey
  - 4. Walsall, Palfrey, Pleck and Caldmore.
- 3.11 Each area mobile team maintains Highway, Schools, Parks, Open Spaces, Retained Housing Land and Social Service locations carrying out grass, shrub bed, hedge and sports pitch maintenance.
- 3.12 Until the baseline standards are defined and adopted, the present grounds maintenance operations and standards will continue to be based around the schedules established and detailed in the MAYRISE management system originally created at the time of Compulsory Competitive Tendering during the late 1980's. Typical maintenance operations and frequency of operations are detailed in Appendix A.

#### 4. Resource and legal considerations:

- 4.1 The grounds maintenance operations are undertaken entirely from within the existing resources held by Street Pride.
- 4.2 There are no anticipated legal resource implications in this review

## 5. Citizen impact:

5.1 Extensive consultation undertaken as part of the Green Space Strategy identified the standards of grounds maintenance as an issue of key concern by local residents and one of the most important areas for improvement.

#### 6. Environmental impact:

6.1 The standards of maintenance achieved or delivered have an impact on residents perceptions and satisfaction with parks and open spaces and local environment. It is an important issue which has a direct impact on their quality of life. Deterioration in standards can lead to an impression of neglect and encourage anti-social behaviour and be a barrier to residents use of parks.

### 7. Performance management:

7.2 The main risk is that the levels of residents satisfaction with the service, they are only average and the parts of the borough is unattractive to inward investment, this has a effect on the overall Council reputation.

## 8. Equality Implications:

8.1 Grounds maintenance service effects most sections of the local authority as well as residents and visitors, our continued monitoring of the service has allowed the service to develop and improve in line with the residents requests and move towards a cleaner, greener and safer environment.

#### 9. Consultation:

9.1 Consultation undertaken as part of the Green Space Strategy has identified grounds maintenance as an area of key concern. The Green STAT Annual Customer Satisfaction Survey introduced by Green Spaces will assist in assessing Residents views on standards and influence future delivery of the service. Service Standards for the service have been introduced to assist to inform residents of what to expect and how to contact us. Local Neighbourhood Partnership meetings have allowed residents to raise enquiries / queries within the service and receive feed back. Friends of the Parks Groups take a active part in how individual parks are used and maintained.
