Update on Previous Actions

Support to concerts at memorial park

Regeneration in Walsall- Simon Tranter

The Borough wide context: Regeneration in Walsall

Instances of Regeneration initiatives have included clearing litter in hotspot areas, transforming derelict sites and enhancing local focal points by improving the lighting on buildings.

There are 3 key areas for regeneration in Walsall, these include:

- 1) Walsall Town Centre
- 2) Districts
- 3) Corridors

Design guide and planning process by the Walsall Regeneration Company need resolution from the LNP in future

In total there are 53 projects in the borough and these will need to be prioritised, Factors are dependent upon match funding and deliverability of projects.

Community Action Group Action Sneet

The local context: Regeneration in Willenhall

Black Country key way

Suggestions to raise the standard of the keyway around the Black Country Route to M6 Junction 10 were discussed. This included replacing overgrown shrubs/planting along the keyway with more structural landscaping, such as distinct art features and high quality advertising screens.

Portobello Roundabout

Improvements to the roundabout and the Assa Abloy site can provide an attractive gateway to Walsall by hard landscaping (replacing shrubs and grass verges with hard paving), As well as introducing an innovative Artscape project, where the community is involved in choosing an appropriate local theme and design to the public art feature.

Willenhall War Memorial

As part of the work being undertaken within the district centre, initial designs were discussed and examples of previous public realm work were shown to highlight the enhancements proposed for the War Memorial. Consultation, supported and undertaken in partnership with the LNP is planned for November 2006- this will include the LNPs idea to utilise the market as a place to reach the wider community.

Lane Head (Short Heath) War Memorial

A site visit has been taken to the site by regeneration officers to appreciate the works required at the site in view of the LNPs desire to fund improvements works (£5k) at this site. This has resulted in the damaged pergola being made safe by the Establishment Service. Further maintenance works are planned. Regeneration officers suggested that it was essential for the maintenance works to be completed before the LNP viewed what other enhancement works could be undertaken with their funding.

Forest Gate (New Invention)

Officers from the Green spaces service undertook a site visit with members of the New Invention Community Forum. An application for funding is being made by the Forum to the Local Area Agreements Green spaces fund that if successful will bring additional funding to that already approved by the LNP (£5). Regeneration officers have agreed to bring an update of the progress of this improvement project to the next CAG.
