

# **Transforming Learning Interest Repayments**

Purpose of the report:	To advise Schools Forum of the level of interest repayments and propose ways in which these funds can be shared or repaid
Recommendations:	That Schools Forum approve action on how to distribute interest repayments.

### 1. General Information

- 1.1. The Building Schools for the Future programme was scrapped in 2010 and funds contributed by schools were returned in October 2010.
- 1.2. Interest on funds up to the end of the 2009/10 have been returned to schools or were used to reduce schools contributions at the time.
- 1.3. However interest accrued for the funds held during 2010-11 until the reimbursement would also have incurred interest. This has now been calculated and can be repaid.

## 2. The amounts to be reimbursed

2.1. **Table 1** shows the interest on the capital balances totalled £6,123 and would be returned to the six BSF schools that contributed capital funding:

2.2. The interest on the revenue balances would apply to every school, and would depend on revenue contributions. A summary of the interest per school is in **Appendix one**. The total revenue interest to be refunded would be £4442.87.

#### 3. Recommendation.

- 3.1. Schools Forum are recommended to choose one of the following courses of action:
  - 3.1.1. To return the revenue funding in 2011/12 as set out in Appendix 1
  - 3.1.2. To use the returned revenue funds in the 2012/13 budget process.
- 3.2. Schools Forum are asked to note the capital re-imbursement
