
2. Recommendation

3. Report detail

The total amount of spend on services for children and young people in Walsall in 2012/13 is in the region of £246.985 million. The detail of the spend per organisation is show in the pie chart below.

- Walsall Council: Public Health

- > Walsall Council: Schools' budget
- Walsall Clinical Commissioning Group

Please note:

- a) NHS England did not exist as an organisation in 2012/13 and so they are not represented in the pie chart.
- b) The information we do have in the pie chart may not capture every bit of spend on children and young people as some budgets are still aggregated and separating spend between adults and children is extremely complicated when this is the case.
- c) The NHS spend is an approximation as it has been difficult to disaggregate some of the budget due to the demise of Walsall PCT splitting into five separate organisations.
