# Amendments to Polling Places outside of the compulsory review period of Polling Districts and Polling Places.

### **Executive Summary report**

The purpose of this report is to present recommendations (contained in <u>Appendix A</u> attached), for consideration by the committee, on changes to Polling Places and Polling stations.

#### Recommendations

That, subject to any comments Members may wish to make, the proposed changes to polling places, contained in <u>Appendix A</u> to this report, be submitted to the Council for approval.

#### **Background information**

Under the provisions of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013, a local authority must carry out and complete a review of all the polling places and districts for UK Parliamentary elections in its area within the period of 16 months beginning from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2013, and the period of 16 months beginning with 1<sup>st</sup> October of every fifth year after that.

The reason for this is to align the reviews with the 5 year Parliamentary periods, and the five year cycle for UK Parliamentary boundary reviews implemented by the Parliamentary Voting System and Constituencies Act 2011.

The last review was completed and the report went to Council in November 2013.

# Making amendments to polling places outside of the compulsory review period and interim reviews.

If a polling station becomes unavailable, the (Acting) Returning Officer can decide to change the location within the designated Polling Place which in most instances the Polling Place has been designated as the polling District. A few instances have arisen whereby alterations need to be made to the designated polling place and the Acting Returning Officer has set out his proposals in the attached Appendix. (Appendix A).

Reason: There has been a change in circumstances at the Cat & Fiddle pub, meaning the car park is now pay and display. It is not possible to suspend parking restrictions due to it being maintained by a private

#### **Recommendation:**

 Following on from the Police and Crime Commissioner election we allocated polling district UF to Park Hall Play group and polling station UE to the Metro Inn as no temporary buildings were available.

We recommend, subject to a visit to the Park Hall Play Group that both electors from Polling District UE and UF be moved there.

Reason: This will alleviate the expense of two temporary buildings located on the shopping precinct. If we make Polling District UE the polling place for UF then this means that we can move the locations of the two polling stations anywhere within UE which is the preferred location to send the voters. If the play group is too small, we can then if required keep UF as one temporary building on the Liskeard shopping precinct and send UE to the Play Group.
