LOCALLY APPOINTED PARTNERS (LAPS) - RECOMMENDATIONS OF SELECTION PANEL

Summary of report:

To enable potential new LAPs to be appointed as soon as possible, it is requested this report be considered as a late item.

This report details the recommendations of the Brownhills and Aldridge North LNP Selection Panel which met on Monday 6 June 2005, to consider the four applications received in respect of the Locally Appointed Partners.

Background:

Article 10 of the Council's Constitution provides that an LNP will consist of Ward Members for the LNP's administrative area, Council Appointed Partners and up to 10 Locally Appointed Partners. Locally Appointed Partners will be chosen by each LNP to reflect the different communities that each LNP serves.

The Brownhills and Aldridge North LNP has four vacancies.

The Selection Panel met on 6 June 2005, and considered each application on its own merit.
