Homeless households who accepted an offer of accommodation	36	47	38	36	157

Further analysed Quarter 4 data by way of example (and could do this, if required for all future data)

- Reason for refusal given by all 13 households: “property unsuitable”
- Only 1 of the 13 households exercised their legal right to appeal against the decision to discharge duty. All applicants are notified of their right to appeal in their decision letter

We can analyse refusal information based on those residing in temporary accommodation and those classed as “homeless at home”
