Progress

 Additional funding for summer play schemes, possibility to link with the summer programme

Sue Grainger attended the June LNP meeting and highlighted the process and criteria for the summer programmes 2005. Sue Grainger agreed to scope the earmarked funding with the suggestions made by the LNP.

The £3,000 from the LNP has been allocated equally between Ready Steady Summer activity providers in the area, which will pay for additional events and activities for children in the LNP area between July and the end of August.

 Railway line hotspot by Hardwick Wood – underage drinking, drugs, access

Awaiting response from Safer Walsall Borough Partnership, they are currently undertaking a prioritisation exercise which this project is being considered within.

Floral displays by Avian Bingo Hall

A site visit has been undertaken by the service area with Councillor Rochelle as the representative from the LNP.

Issues highlighted were to tidy up the brick piers by the Bingo and to have floral displays by the brick piers.

The total cost of the work to be undertaken was £880 which would include three half barrels of flowers and plants.

The floral displays programme will be extended across the LNP area in the next year. Floral displays by the bingo hall will be provided by mainstream provision.

Environment Regeneration have completed this work through their budgets.

Work was completed in the last week of July.
