Licence Hearing

Application for a Premises Licence Variation under Section 34 of the Licensing Act, 2003 – 1 Whittimere Street, Walsall, WS1 1SS.

Councillor Sears explained the purpose of the meeting and requested the Principal Licensing Officer (Mr. Knapper) to explain the application.

The Legal representative (Mr. Patouchas) informed the Sub-Committee that the variation application had been made under Section 34 of the Licensing Act, 2003. However, having obtained further legal opinion it was felt that the change from a Snooker Hall to a Dance venue should not be dealt with as a variation of the licence but should be considered as a new application under Section 17 of the Act. In view of this information it would not be possible to determine the matter today as Industry for Music Ltd would need to submit a fresh application under Section 17 of the Act for determination and the entire licensing process would have to be carried out again to allow relevant parties an opportunity to object to the proposals.

Mr. Patouchas added that if the variation application was to be considered for the premises then it would leave the granting of the licence open to challenge.

That the application for the variation of a premises licence under Section 34 of the Licensing Act, 2003 in respect of 1 Whittimere Street, Walsall be rescinded and a new application under Section 17 of the Act be considered on a date to be determined.
