#### Report:

At its meeting on 8 June 2009 the Community Services Scrutiny and Performance Panel agreed to establish a working group to consider alcohol related anti-social behaviour following a recommendation made by the former Neighbourhoods Scrutiny and Performance Panel during 2008/09.

The commencement of the working group was postponed whilst the Panel reviewed Bryntysilio Outdoor Education Centre and was reconvened following its conclusion.

The working group held a meeting on 5 February 2010 to draft its terms of reference. Members have agreed that the focus of their investigation will be problem public houses in the borough. To assist in their investigations the working group would like to appoint a representative of West Midlands Police Authority into their Membership, and subject to the confirmation of the Panel, Councillor Eddie Hughes has been approached to complete this role.

The working group have noted that it is unlikely that they will have completed their investigations and final report before the last scheduled meeting of the Panel. To this end the working group are requesting that a special Panel meeting is called towards the end of April 2010 to allow them to present their report and recommendations before the end of the municipal year.

A copy of the draft terms of reference is attached at Appendix 1 to this report for consideration by the Panel.

The working group will focus on the policies of the Council and its partners from a community safety perspective.

Issues and matters concerning licensing decisions will generally be excluded from the working groups remit.
