Appointment to the position of Chair of Employment Appeals Committee 'A'

1.0 Report Detail

- 1.1 On 18th November, 2019, Councillor Allen, the Chair of Employment Appeals Committee 'A', gave notice of his resignation from this position.
- 1.2 Accordingly, this report seeks to make an appointment to that now vacant position of Chair and to nominate another Conservative Member to the Committee to fill the vacancy left by Councillor Allen.
- 1.3 Any appointment to this position must be from the Conservative Group to maintain the Political Balance on the Sub-Committee, which comprises seven Members in total. This equates to four Conservative Members and three Labour Members.

2.0 Recommendations

- 2.1 That Personnel Committee appoints another Member to the Employment Appeals Committee 'A' from the Conservative Group to replace Councillor Allen and to maintain Political Balance on the Committee.
- 2.2 That Personnel Committee appoints a Member to the position of Chair of Employment Appeals Committee 'A', for the remainder of the 2019/20 Municipal Year only, from amongst the Employment Appeals Committee 'A' Membership.
