8. Revision to the 5.12.06

Revision to the Scheme of Financing Schools

A report was submitted.

The Forum accepted the recommendations of the report with regard to Multi Year Budgets, the FMiS and the Notice of Concern. There was further discussion over the Balance Control Mechanism.

There was general agreement that it was unacceptable for schools to carry forward large amounts, if the schools were being paid the incorrect rate for the work they were doing, or if there were insufficient resources being spent on basic materials.

Mr McQueen indicated that Education Walsall wished to deal in an open and transparent manner where requests were made for "assigned projects".

From the Chair, Mr Chomyk enquired who would decide whether a project would be deemed as "properly assigned". Mr McQueen replied that this was the Authority's decision, but took note of the view expressed by Forum members that projects should be scrutinized by a group, rather than one person.

In relation to the proposed revision to Walsall's Scheme of Financing Schools, namely:-
