Feedback from Task Groups

A task group was held on Monday 12th December 2005 at Aldridge School. The task group focused upon highlighting issues and concerns highlighted in the Partnership Plan to date and linking the issues with the Local Area Agreement themes of Safer and Stronger Communities, Children and Young People, Healthier Communities and vulnerable People and Economic Development and Enterprise.

Following on from this, a task group meeting was held on Thursday 26th January 2006, whereby attendees were given a further opportunity to raise any issues that were affecting them or their local neighbourhoods. These were clustered in the Local Area Agreement themes. The task group undertook a prioritisation exercise whereby they highlighted the key areas that the LNP would focus upon in the next 12 months (2006-2007).
