# Practical Learning

## 1. <u>Purpose of the Report</u>

The purpose of the report is to bring further information to members of the Forum on the disbursement of funds to secondary schools for practical learning.

#### 2. <u>Background</u>

The Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) for 2006/07 and the indicative grant for 2007/08 contain earmarked funding to increase practical learning opportunities for 14 - 16 year old pupils. It is up to the Schools Forum to agree a methodology for the distribution of the funding amongst secondary schools.

It is intended that this funding should enable secondary schools to secure a broader range of practical and specialist provision at Key Stage 4. The purpose of the funding is to cover additional core costs of delivery. It will also enable schools to purchase provision, which they could not themselves directly provide, from other schools, colleges or private providers.

Secondary Headteachers have been consulted on possible funding methodologies. At their meeting of 28<sup>th</sup> March 2006, Forum members requested that additional work be carried out on the models available.

#### 3. <u>Recommendation</u>

Members of the Forum are recommended to adopt the methodology for the distribution of practical learning funds in the 2006/07 year, as described in the appendix attached to this report.
