The Committee agreed first to deal with the items on the Agenda where members of the public had previously indicated that they wished to address the Committee. The Chair, at the beginning of each item for which there were speakers advised the procedure whereby the speaker would have three minutes to speak and then at two minutes they would be reminded that they had a minute left.

1936/08 Item No. 1 – 08/0901/FL – demolition of redundant boiler house and replacement with bottling plant and tankroom building at Highgate Brewery, Sandymount Road, Walsall

Item No. 2 – 08/0898/LB – Listed Building Consent: demolition of redundant boiler house and replacement with bottling plant and tankroom building at Highgate Brewery, Sandymount Road, Walsall

The Chairman sought the Committee's approval to consider both applications together, as they related to the same site. The Committee agreed that the applications be considered together.

The Planning Officer then advised the Committee of the background to the report and drew members attention to the supplementary paper circulated at the meeting.

Officers from Regeneration and Environmental Health were then invited to speak with regard to ecology and noise mitigation matters.

The Committee then welcomed the first speaker on this item Councillor McCracken, who spoke against the applications.

The Committee then welcomed the second speaker on this item Sue Machin, who also spoke in objection to the applications.

There then followed a period of questioning by Members in relation to the number of complaints received regarding the site, the proposed conditions to address the concerns of residents should the application be approved, noise mitigation measures and whether the brewery could use the existing building as a bottling plant.

In response, Officers stated that the recommended conditions were designed to ensure that the residents' quality of life would be protected. Furthermore,

the brewery could lawfully operate a bottling plant using the current structure, without seeking consent from the Authority.

Members considered the application and Councillor Pitt **moved** and it was duly **seconded** by Councillor Hughes:-

That planning application No. **08/0901/FL** be approved subject to the conditions as contained in the report and supplementary paper now submitted and an additional condition that the windows on the building be non-opening.

The motion having been put to the vote, was declared **tied**, with 6 members voting in favour of the application and 6 against.

The Chair exercised his right to a casting vote (in accordance with part 4 paragraph 18.2 of the Councils Constitution) in favour of approving the application.

## Resolved (7 in favour and 6 against)

That planning application No. **08/0901/FL** be approved subject to the conditions as contained in the report and supplementary paper now submitted and an additional condition to ensure that the windows on the new building are non-opening.

Councillor Micklewright requested her name be recorded as having abstained from voting on this application.

Councillor Arif requested his name be recorded as having voted against this application.

Councillor Madeley having declared a prejudicial interest in this item left the room during deliberation and did not take part or vote.

Members further considered planning application No. 08/0898/LB relating to Listed Building Consent at Highgate Brewery.

Members considered the application and Councillor Pitt **moved** and it was duly **seconded** by Councillor Hughes:-

That planning application No. **08/0898/LB** be granted listed building consent subject to the conditions as contained in the report now submitted.

The motion having been put to the vote, was declared **carried**, with members voting in favour of granting listed building consent.
