# **Designation of Statutory Scrutiny Officer**

## 1. Report detail

The Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act 2009 directs that a local authority in England must designate one of their officers to discharge the following functions:

- (a) to promote the role of the authority's Overview and Scrutiny Committee or Committees:
- (b) to provide support to the authority's Overview and Scrutiny Committee or Committees and the members of that Committee or those Committees;
- (c) to provide support and guidance to:
  - (I) members of the authority.
  - (ii) members of the executive of the authority, and
  - (iii) officers of the authority, in relation to functions of the authority's Overview and Scrutiny Committee or Committees.

The Act stipulates that a local authority may not designate any of the following under this section of the Act:

- (a) the head of the authority's paid service designated under Section 4 of the Local Government and Housing Act, 1989;
- (b) the authority's monitoring officer designated under Section 5 of that Act;
- (c) the authority's chief finance officer, within the meaning of that section.

### 2. **Recommendation**

That the Executive Director, Social Care and Inclusion be designated as the Statutory Scrutiny Officer.

#### 3. **Resource implications**

- 3.1 **Financial**: All costs are contained within existing budgets.
- 3.2 **Legal**: The designated post is necessary to ensure compliance with the Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act, 2009.
