# Caldmore Community Garden Outdoor Cinema Equipment Consultation

## 1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 This report seeks to inform Elected Members for the Walsall South Area Partnership of the consultation carried out on the Panel's behalf. This consultation was requested by Elected Members to be carried out by the Area Manager at the last Area Panel meeting on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2015. The purpose is to inform Elected Members of residents' views to help with the decision on the funding application received. The information in this report was correct at the time of writing, Friday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2015.

#### 2. Caldmore Community Garden outdoor cinema equipment consultation

- 2.2 Residents in St Michael Street, Carless Street and part of Bath Road; sixty-five households in total, where posted a consultation letter (please see appendix 1).
- 2.3 From the sixty-five letters sent only one response has been received by the deadline of Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2015. The respondent stated:

"I am opposed to the Community Garden's plan for an outdoor cinema project to screen cultural films for the benefit of the Caldmore & Palfrey community. My reasons are that it would cause nuisance in terms of (i) noise, (ii) litter problem, which is already quite severe on St Michael Street, and finally (iii) low-level anti-social behaviour".
