Aldridge South and Streetly LNP

Purpose

To consult Aldridge South and Streetly LNP on draft proposals for enhancement works to the Aldridge War Memorial.

Background

As part of the Walsall Strategic Corridors and Gateways Regeneration Initiative an Urban Design Framework has been prepared which sets out how the Strategic Road Corridors (A454 and A461) can be enhanced.

As part of the initiative a series of projects were proposed the first of which is the enhancement of the Aldridge War Memorial which is located along the A454 and is considered to be an important gateway into Aldridge and the Borough.

Stonework, stone walls and pathways of the memorial site have suffered from wear and tear and are now in need of enhancement to bring them back to a high standard; and thus provide the site with the quality that this important gateway feature of the town and borough deserves.

The project manager will work with Establishment and Streetpride to ensure that once completed, the war memorial can be maintained to ensure the standards are sustained.

The enhancements will be funded by the Council's Capital Programme

Enhancements may involve:

- Hard and soft landscaping
- Enhancement of Street Furniture
- Lighting of the monument

A draft plan for the proposed enhancement works will be presented at the meeting for comments and discussions.
