LNP Funding

Purpose of the Report

Progress on projects 2005-2006 (other projects are complete)

Heritage project: an opening day took place on 18th October where local people had the opportunity to be shown the new equipment such as the microfiche readers. There were also talks on local history complemented with a local history display.

Potential projects for 2006-2007

These signs can be located throughout Brownhills and Aldridge North if the LNP
agree to the funding.
