# Resolved

- (2) That Cabinet agree to engage with key stakeholders on the proposals set out in the 'Governance Review', and raise awareness amongst our partners of the West Midlands Combined Authority and the content of the 'Statement of Intent'- Appendix 2 of the report,

- (3) That Cabinet, in order to progress the Council's interest in the creation of a combined authority for the West Midlands, agrees to delegate the responsibility for the consideration of the initial membership, rights and obligations of the West Midlands Combined Authority to the Leader of the Council through his role on the proposed Shadow Board.
- (4) That Cabinet, in order to meet the timescales set down by Government, delegate responsibility to the Leader of the Council, through his role on the proposed Shadow Board to agree the early propositions that form the West Midlands 'Devolution Deal'.
- (5) That Cabinet agree to receive final proposals and documentation referred to in paragraphs (3.6) to (3.14), together with the findings of the engagement exercise, informing the creation of a Combined Authority for consideration at a future meeting of the Cabinet.
- (6) That Cabinet approves a budget of £300,000 as a contribution towards the costs of bringing about the creation of the West Midlands Combined Authority.
