LOCALLY APPOINTED PARTNERS (LAPS) - RECOMMENDATION OF SELECTION PANEL

Summary of report:

This report details the recommendations of the St. Matthews and Birchills/Leamore LNP Selection Panel which met on Tuesday, 1st March, 2005, to consider a further application received in respect of the appointment as a Locally Appointed Partner.

Background:

Article 10 of the Council's Constitution provides that an LNP will consist of Ward Members for the LNP's administrative area, Council Appointed Partners and up to 10 Locally Appointed Partners. Locally Appointed Partners will be chosen by each LNP to reflect the different communities that each LNP serves. At the present time, there are nine Locally Appointed Partners on the Local Neighbourhood Partnership.

The Selection Panel (which consisted of one Ward Member from each of the Wards within the LNP area, one Council Appointed Partner and a representative from the Community Enpowerment Network) met on 1st March, 2005 and considered the application on its own merit.

Recommendation:

That having considered the application on its own merit, the St. Matthews and Birchills/Leamore LNP be recommended to appoint the person listed below as a Locally Appointed Partner (LAP) for the remainder of the current Municipal Year:-
