Progress

- Ready Steady Summer

£3,000 has been spent on providing additional activities during the Ready Steady Summer Programme. This project has now been completed

- Streetly Association, refurbishment of changing rooms

The proposed work to the changing rooms has now been completed. £10,000 was allocated towards this by the LNP.

- Railway line hotspot by Hardwick Wood

An update will be provided at the LNP meeting.

- Redhouse Estate Environmental Scheme

The money will be spent upon landscaping design projects to link with Britain in Bloom which will be in the spring time. An update will be provided at the next LNP meeting

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
