Description

The Councillors Commission found that a request for basic forms of support came top of a 'wish list' of requirements to help councillors perform their role. The support councillors may get from their council is varied across the country. Support can also be a make or break issue for councillors considering whether to stand again or indeed whether to resign midterm. The Commission suggested that authorities provide a minimum standard of support for all elected members and that the IDeA could support this by means of a charter.

This seminar invites officers and members to walk in each others shoes and increase their knowledge of each others roles. Delegates will also consider how authorities could meet the Commission's suggested minimum standard of support.

Sharing knowledge and experience with each other delegates will be invited to consider how they might develop cross-service support packages for councillors that provide the support that members are looking for and that make best use of a councillor's time.
