Public Health (Control of Disease) Act 1984 The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (England) Regulations 2020

I write to inform you that an allegation has been received that King George V, Wallows Lane, Walsall, West Midlands, WS2 9BZ was operating in a way that would contravene the above regulations.

Please could you contact this department using contact the details at the top of this letter to confirm that your business has put the necessary measures in place to ensure that you are complying with the requirements of the abovementioned regulations.

Throughout Walsall random unannounced physical or social media monitoring of premises may be carried out by local authority staff or West Midlands Police to ensure that the requirements of the legislation are being properly met and observed.

This monitoring will take place for the duration of the current regulations or for 3 months whichever ends sooner.
