Report to Willenhall & Short Heath Area Panel

Funding Report

26 March 2014

1. Context

- 1.1 Following the change to the Council's Constitution in May 2013, Area Panels now have the responsibility for approving any project funding applications that are received through Area Partnerships.
- 1.2 This report sets out any project applications that have been carried forward from the previous financial year, projects that have been approved under urgency by Area Managers, in consultation with the Area Chair and Vice Chair and relevant Ward Councillors) and those projects that are being put forward for consideration by the Area Panel (attached at Appendix 1).
- 1.3 Any project applications received by the Area Partnership team, will be assessed against a set of criteria (the delivery of the Area Community Plan and The Walsall Plan) before being put forward to the Area Panel for consideration. Only valid applications that fulfil the criteria will be put to the Area Panel for decision.
- 1.4 Any projects that do not meet the criteria will be referred back to the project applicant for further information or a resubmission.

3.1 Below are projects that were approved in financial year 2013/14, but, for various reasons, were not completed in that financial year, therefore, a request has been made and accepted to carry forward these funds for projects to be completed during this financial year:

- 3.2 At the area panel dated 3rd September 2013 the area panel agreed to allocate £10,000 to Participatory Budgeting, following this allocation at the panel meeting 20th March 2014 the panel agreed to allocate £7024 to projects with the remaining £2976 being claimed back to the central budget for the financial year 2013-2014.
- From the carry forward request of £7024 at the area panel meeting dated 20th March 2014 there is currently only £1000 allocated to a project with the remaining £6024 to be allocated in the financial year 2014-2015. At the panel meeting dated 01.07.2014 it was agreed that this funding be split equally between three wards, totalling £2008 per ward.

4 Project Applications for Consideration

- 4.1 Attached at Appendix 1 are the summarised project applications deemed valid against Area Partnership funding criteria and put forward to the Area Panel for consideration.
- 4.2 The total proposed projects in Appendix 1 for the panels' consideration is £1160.00
- 4.3 If the projects presented at Appendix 1 are approved, this will leave a total of £11,870.80 to approve project applications for the remainder of the financial year as presented in Table 2 by ward/area budget.
- 4.4 At the panel meeting dated 1, July 2014 it was agreed that the funding be allocated as per the following breakdown and for the funding to be utilised in a participatory budgeting exercise;

The Area Panels £40,000 funding allocation be split in the following way:-

- a) £10,000 for Short Heath Ward plus £2,008 from the £6,024 carried forward from 2013/14 Participatory Budgeting exercise giving a total area allocation of £12008
- b) £10,000 for Willenhall North Ward plus £2,008 from the £6,024 carried forward from 2013/14 Participatory Budgeting exercise giving a total area allocation of £12008
- c) £10,000 for Willenhall South Ward plus £2,008 from the £6,024 carried forward from 2013/14 Participatory Budgeting exercise giving a total area allocation of £12008
- d) £10,000 for area wide projects (to be utilised for projects that area across each of the wards)
- 4.4 All projects presented to the panel and approved to date leave a balance of £12830.80 remaining for allocation to project applications for the remainder of the financial year broken down by ward as follows
 - Willenhall North £3456.69
 - Willenhall South £2506.66
 - Short Heath £5005.67
 - Area Wide £1861.78
