Membership of Local Neighbourhood Partnerships

Summary of report

This report enables the Council to consider extending the term of office of the locally appointed partners on Local Neighbourhood Partnerships (LNPs).

Recommendations

That approval be given to the extension of the term of office of all locally appointed partners for this municipal year.

Background

1. At the Annual Council meeting in June 2004 it was agreed, that each Local Neighbourhood Partnership would consist of up to 10 locally appointed partners and that these would be selected by each LNP to reflect the different communities which each LNP serves. As a result of the selection process and the necessary advertising which was part of the process, none of the locally appointed partners, however, had the opportunity to serve on the Committee for a full municipal year.
2. In addition, it is becoming apparent that in order for the partners to play a full part in the work of the Committees it would be appropriate for the terms of office to be extended. In order to allow for a full discussion on the options this report recommends extending the term of office for a further municipal year.
