Summary of report

The purpose of this report is to inform the LNP of the progress of the various task groups.

Feedback from workshops

28th February – Anti Social Behaviour – this meeting looked at issues around anti social behaviour. Specifically, the future of wardens was discussed and the implications on the area of downsizing the wardens service. Representative from Safer Walsall Borough Partnership attended to inform the LNP that the Community Safety Intervention Group will be targeting resources into Willenhall for a 6 week period during April/May.

27th March - Anti Social Behaviour – this meeting focused on 'community action meetings', which are meetings where local people interact with the local police and where possible influence the police work priority on a local level. The LNP agreed this is identical to what the LNP are trying to achieve and therefore should work closely with the police to make this happen. LNP agreed to invite Inspector Mick Williams to provide a more in depth presentation on community action meetings and share his ideas on how the LNP's and community action meetings can work and be established collectively.

12th April – Neighbourhood Policing – as a follow up from the previous workshop the neighbourhood policing team were invited to provide a presentation on the new policing of the area and community action meetings.
