### **Report to Aldridge and Beacon Area Panel**

### **Funding Report**

#### **08 December 2015**

#### 1. Context

- 1.1 Following the change to the Council's Constitution in May 2013, Area Panels now have the responsibility for approving any project funding applications that are received through Area Partnerships.
