Projects Updates

Christmas Lights:

Councillor Angela Underhill (champion for the project) has been instructed by the council that she needs to acquire 3 quotes before spending any money. She is due to meet suppliers within the next 2 weeks who will advise on how best to spend the money and will provide quotes. Following this, the best value option will be selected.

Kick Start Community Safety:

Within the new theme of 'Present – Here & Now' workshop one of the issues the LNP will be tackling is Anti Social Behaviour. Anti social behaviour can clearly encompass community safety issues therefore this money will be held until the LNP identify which areas suffer the most from community safety concerns and further identify a project(s) to kick start the community safety within Willenhall.

• Youth Engagement project:

Within the new theme of 'Present – Here & Now' workshop one of the issues the LNP will be tackling is Youth Engagement. The LNP are currently identifying youth provision and facilities in the area. Following further discussions the LNP will identify a project(s) to start engaging young people of the area.
