Safer Walsall Borough Partnership Borough Resource Allocation Group (BRAG)

Background

The Borough Resource Allocation Group is a management group of key partners and service providers, who meet monthly, to review and analyse current community safety data across the Borough

The group makes recommendations to the Safer Walsall Borough Partnership who task and coordinate resources in a multi agency response in order to improve hot spot neighbourhood issues and to meet the strategic objectives outlined in the strategy

Principal issues for neighbourhood selection include hot spot locations, crime trends and trends in public perception

Purpose and Recommendation

- To inform the LNP that the BRAG will be co-ordinating its resources across Pheasey and Paddock from Monday 14th November 2005 to Friday 9th December 2005
- For Pheasey and Paddock LNP to highlight 3-5 priority themes for consideration by the BRAG
