- High perinatal and Infant mortality (under remit of CYP pillar)
- High Teenage conception (under remit of CYP pillar)
- Low Cervical screening and Flu Uptake
- Reduced life expectancy

Solutions:

- Reduce perinatal mortality - aligned to the CYP pillar
- Supporting mums in inappropriate housing (Home Start; Sian Brace)
- Promote work around Domestic violence
- Reduce Smoking
- Raise awareness about Alcohol and Healthy Eating
- Work around self esteem of young people through education
- Renewal of condom corner project (previously the system was being abused by individuals)
- Education of what services exist and where to access these types of services
- LNP to champion the awareness of governors of these "health issues"
- Mapping of schools with regard to teenage pregnancy levels and whether they have sex education (tPCT)
- Information on where screening is taking place
- Support 'What would it mean' Programme
- Support Walsall Pregnancy Help (WPH)
