Shortfall in funding has been secured for the above project and the scheme is now out to tender / quotations with a view to appointing the contractor early January and completion of the project before the end of March 2007

Shelter at Pleck Park - £5,000

The Friends of Pleck Park have secured £10,000 towards the replacement shelter project from Walsall's Local Area Agreement, meaning that £15,000 is now secured for the project and there is a commitment from Greenspace Services to supply the additional funds needed.

The order for the shelter will be placed before Christmas and funding will be spent by 31st March 2006.
