#### **1. Summary**

The Environment Scrutiny and Performance Panel's report on Scrap Metal was presented to Council on 23 February 2012, whereby it was resolved:

#### **3. Scrap Metal working group report**

- 3.1 At its meeting on 20 October 2011, the Environment Scrutiny and Performance Panel considered a report on businesses dealing in scrap metal. This followed a motion passed at Council requesting that the relevant Scrutiny and Performance Panel undertake an investigation into the matter.
- 3.2 The Panel subsequently established a working group, who submitted their report to the Panel on 9 February 2011. The Panel approved the report and referred it to Council on 23 February 2012.

- 3.3 In accordance with the motion passed at Council, the findings of the investigation have been produced in a report for submission to Council and Cabinet.
