NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PASS A RESOLUTION ON STREET TRADING AND THE DESIGNATION OF ALL STREETS IN THE BOROUGH AS CONSENT STREET

Notice is hereby given that the Council's Licensing and safety committee intend to pass a Resolution under Para 2 Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 (subject to consultation responses) that all the Street (as defined by s329 of the Highways Act 1980) in the Borough of Walsall be designated as consent streets.

The terms of the draft resolution are as follows:

That all 'streets' as defined in schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 i.e all road, footways, service areas (as defined by section 329 of the Highways Act 1980), beaches or other areas to which the public have access without payment in the controlled borough of Walsall be designated as consent streets allowing trade at specific locations and specific times of the day, subject to a full application and consultation process..
