The Principal Licensing Officer (Mr. Knapper) enlarged upon the report and drew the Committee's attention to the salient points. He added that the Council already had standard conditions for sex shops and cinemas. The Government had introduced the concept of sexual entertainment venues which had been agreed by the Council on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2011; because of this, it was felt pertinent to produce a new set of guidelines/conditions for such venues.

Consultations had been undertaken with West Midlands Police, licensing solicitors and potential licence holders between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2011 and had resulted in the policy before the Committee. He asked the Committee to endorse the proposed guidelines contained in the Appendix to the report.

Several Members expressed concern that if a licence was granted for a sex establishment then it could put pressure on the Local Authority to grant planning permission for the venue. Steven Knapper reported that under the licensing process, any applications for sex establishments would be submitted to this Committee in all cases, and that the Planning Department was already a consultee on all such applications.

Councillor Rochelle asked if a licence would be an annual licence. Mr. Knapper confirmed that it would. He also confirmed that the fee was payable on application.

After further discussion it was,

**Resolved** (Councillors Russell and Wilkes voting against)

That the implementation of a new sex establishment policy/guidelines for the Borough, as contained in the Appendix to the report, be agreed.

The Principal Licensing Officer (Mr. Knapper) enlarged upon the report and circulated additional material from Nikki Sinclaire, MEP, to Members present at the meeting:-

He reminded the Committee that the siting of the mobile surgery could only be located in Park Street, St. Paul's Square or Gallery Square within Walsall Town Centre. He added that Miss Sinclaire's constituency covered 33 Councils and that she represented a total of 5.1 million constituents. Currently only Walsall had not been visited in her region. She had not encountered any difficulties when visiting other Authorities. He asked the Committee to recommend to Council whether permission for the use of a promotional site under Section 115(E) of the Highways Act, 1980 should be granted or refused.

Several Members expressed concern that the siting of the mobile advice surgery did not meet the Regulations contained in Appendix 3 of the report for the control of temporary exhibitions, displays, street entertainment, charitable and commercial activities on the highway and should be refused.

#### Resolved

That Council be recommended to refuse permission for the use of a promotional site as requested by Nikki Sinclaire, MEP, under Section 115(E) of the Highways Act, 1980 as it does not meet the prescribed Regulations.
