The Prevention of Crime and Disorder				
As part of the 2020 review of the Statement of Licensing Policy Responsible authorities				
provided evidence that the WS1 post code area for Walsall was saturated with licensed premises ('on/off licences' and late night refreshment) and the level of saturation was				
having a significant cumulative effect, which undermined the licensing objectives.				
In light of the number of licensed premises with both off sales/on sales and also late night				
refreshments an additional premises within this area, having another off licence would				
merely add to an already saturated location.
