

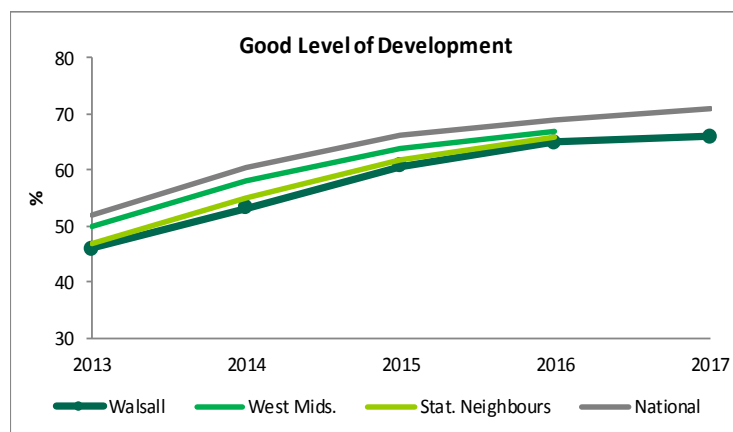
# Walsall Data Summary 2017

## EYFSP<sup>1</sup>

### Good Level of Development

The percentage of pupils achieving a 'Good Level of Development' (GLD) within Walsall has improved by 1% from 65% in 2016 to 66% in 2017. National outcomes for this measure have improved by 2% this year from 69% in 2016 to 71% in 2017. The gap to national has increased slightly by one percentage point from 4% to 5%

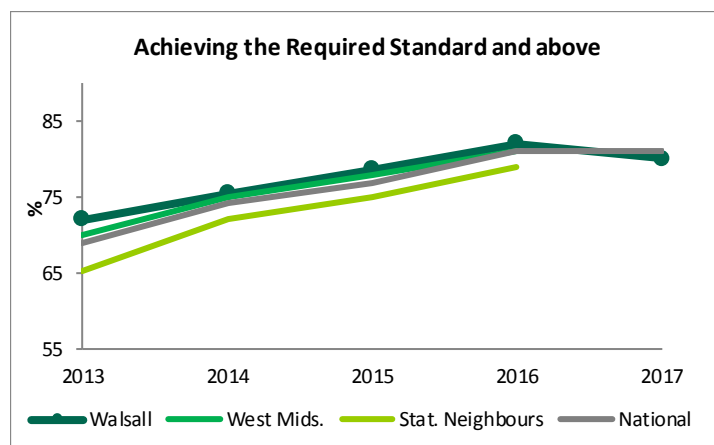


## Y1 Phonics

### Achieving the Expected Level

The percentage of pupils passing the year 1 phonics screening test in Walsall has declined by 2% from 82% to 80% in 2017. This outcome is 1% below national, the first time Walsall has been below national since the tests inception in 2012. The national pass rate has remained unchanged from last year.

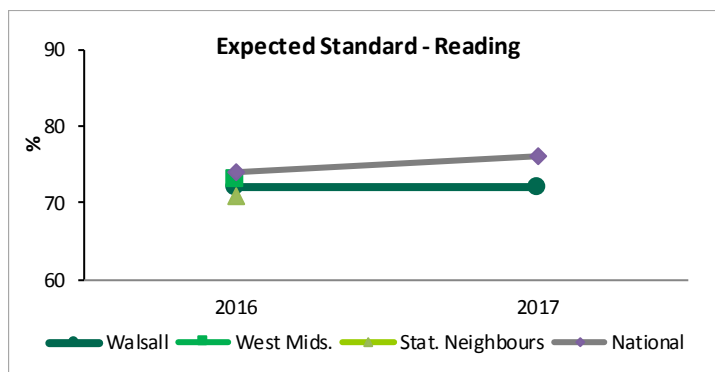

## KS1 – Expected Standard

72% of pupils have reached the Expected Standard and above in Reading in Walsall. This is compared to 76% nationally. In Writing, 63% of pupils have achieved the threshold compared to 68% nationally. In Maths, 73% achieved at least the expected standard which is two percentage points below the national outcome of 75%. There has been a decline in the percentage of pupils who achieved a greater depth in Reading and Writing this year, whilst maths has stayed the same at 15%

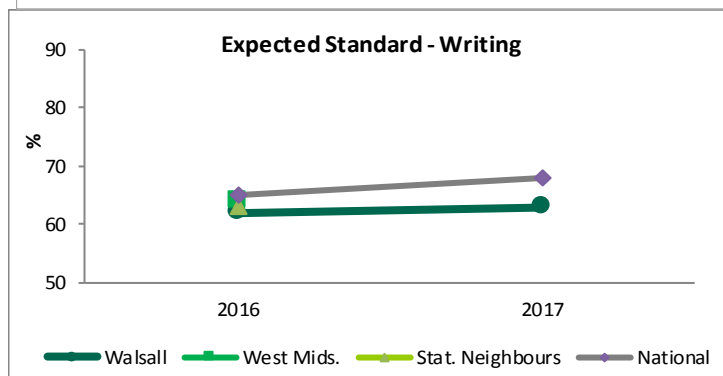

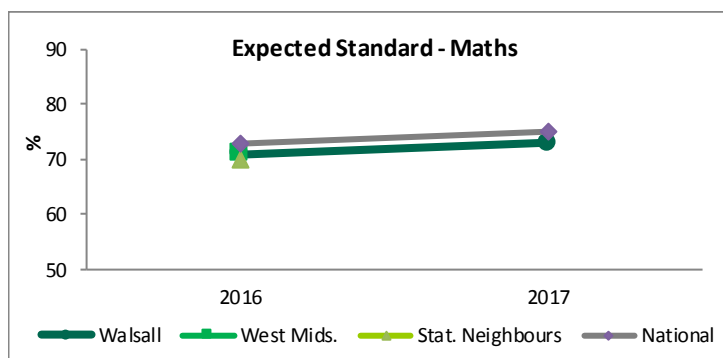

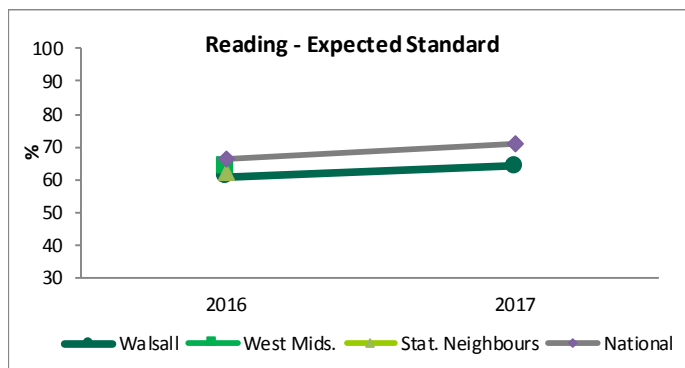


## KS2 – Expected Standard

The percentage of pupils in Walsall who achieved the expected standard or above in combined Reading, Writing and maths stands at 52%, an increase of 2% from 2016. However, Walsall are significantly below the national outcome of 61% by 9 percentage points. Achievement at a higher standard shows that 5% of Walsall pupils achieved this threshold compared to 9% nationally.

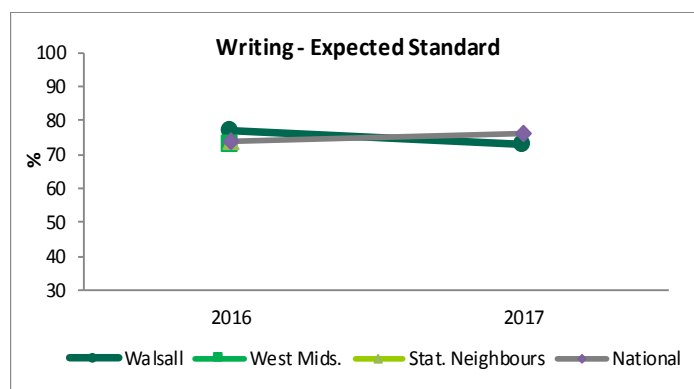

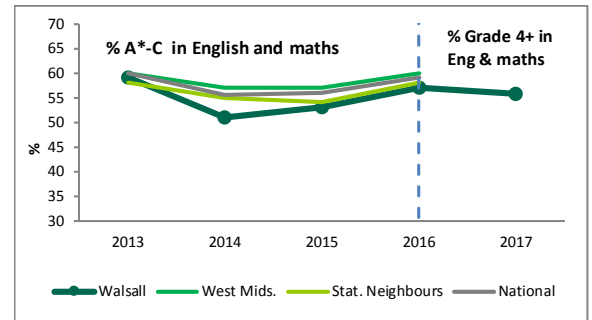
## KS4

For 2017 results GCSEs in English and mathematics are being reformed in English and mathematics and will be graded with a new scale from 9 to 1, with 9 being the highest grade. For most other subjects the new grades will be awarded in 2018. A new grade 4 will be seen as a "standard pass" and a grade 5 as a "strong pass". The Grade 5 'strong pass' will be included in the new accountability measure for schools.

2017 data is based on the latest results collection submitted to the LA by schools. Provisionally, 56% of pupils have achieved a Grade 4 or above in English and maths in Walsall, with 19% of pupils in Walsall achieving the English Baccalaureate

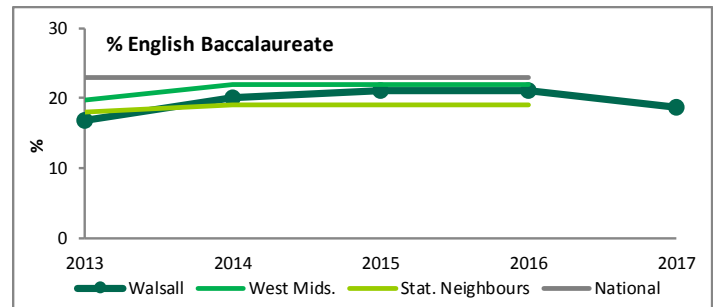
