PROPOSED CONDITIONS BY APPLICANT

(a) General – all four licensing objectives

- 1. Appropriate and effective training will be given to all staff and ensure that there are sufficient and competent staff at the premises, fulfilling the terms and condition of the licence
- 2. Records will be kept, and refresher training will be ongoing
- 3. CCTV to be installed and maintained for 31 hours
- 4. CCTV shall be provided to Police and/or local authority upon request within 48 hours
- 5. Should CCTV become inoperable it will be reported to the Police and Licensing Authority as soon as practicable and immediate steps taken to ensure it becomes operable
- 6. All staff shall receive training around alcohol abuse and awareness
- 7. A log will record incidents involving public disorder
- 8. Signage stating 'NO PROOF OF AGE, NO SALE' Shall be displayed
- 9. Fire exits to be checked on a regular basis and remain clear with no obstructions
- 10. Smoke detectors will be installed and regularly inspected
- 11. Staff to be trained as Fire Marshalls
- 12. Fire extinguishers and Fire blankets to be installed at the premises
- 13. Notices to be displayed reminding customers to keep noise to a minimum
- 14. Challenge 25 Policy to be implemented, whereby any customer who appears to be under 25 will produce a valid ID.

(b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- 1. Effective and responsible management of premises
- 2. Training and supervision of staff
- 3. Provision and monitoring of CCTV during all licensable hours
- 4. Provision of a secure deposit box
- 5. Licensed door staff (on weekends)

- 4. Appropriate training and supervision

- 2. Control of operating hours
- 3. Position of external public lighting
- 4. Adoption of best practice guidance
- 5. Provision of effective CCTV

(e) The protection of children from harm

- 1. Limitations or exclusions by age when certain activities are taking place
- 2. Requirements for children to be accompanied by an adult
- 3. Acceptance of accredited identification cards
- 4. Sufficient number of staffing present at the premises always

Public Nuisance

- 1. There will be a limiter fitted to the sound system to control the base and treble level to ensure that the noise is controlled to a level as to not cause a nuisance and this is set by an independent party and will be only background level only.
- 2. Windows and doors will be kept closed after 10 pm

Crime and Disorder

- 1. The premises will be a member of Pubwatch
- 2. The premises will adopt the Radio Link System.
- 3. Opening Hours, the applicant has agreed to the hours being reduced to close at 11 pm rather 00.30.
