Safer & Stronger CAG - 6th July 2006

This CAG focused on litter related issues, Streetpride representative led on the meeting informing partners of the current legislation around litter enforcement and provided useful information on what the council are doing to combat litter hotspots. As part of the resulting actions the LNP agreed to highlight 3 litter hotspots which will be added to a list of potential sites to receive CCTV surveillance. An action list from the CAG has been circulated to all LNP members and attendees of the CAG.

Health & People CAG - 7th August 2006

The health and people CAG concentrated on the pledge of the LNP's concerns around the lack of health screening facilities in the LNP area. Tpct representatives including the public health screening manager facilitated the meeting which led to a string of actions to forward the agenda of improving health screening. The Tpct agreed to carry out feasibility checks on a location which could potentially be used to home a mobile screening unit.
